# What matters to you

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and will prioritise the following,

- Anti-social behaviour There is an increase in ASB with youths around Syston, ranging from egg throwing, knock a door run, criminal damage such as, fires, any noise and nuisance. We are aware of this ASB happening not only in Syston and we are trying our best to deter this by showing Police presence. Any individuals involved will be spoken too and the correct action will be taken. We have a ASB Car every night which will cover the whole of Charnwood, the officers who are tasked the ASB Car will tackle key areas and hotspots for ASB.
- Car cruise Cars racing around Thurmaston and Syston. We are fully aware of this and the correct procedures are being taken. We have marked Police cars at the location of the Car Cruise every week (when possible) which helps to deter any vehicles causing any nuisance to the community and stop them racing. All vehicles that are caught racing or causing a nusiance will receive consequences with the correct procedures followed.

## What we will do

To tackle the issues raised we will conduct a number of focused actions which will include;


- Regular high visibility patrols of high harm areas
- \* Engagements covering crime prevention, personal safety, cycle security and advice
- \* Planned operations to tackle the use of E-bikes/E-scooters and cycle theft
- \* Support retailers to reduce retail crime
- \* Target offenders that cause harm in our community and seek conditions and orders to prevent

# What to be aware of!

#### **BONFIRE NIGHT:**

Remember to be safe using fireworks and use them appropriately as by the laws stated below. Ensure the anyone under the age of 18 years old does not have access to fireworks.

### Laws around using fireworks:

- Fireworks must not be set off from 11pm 7am, except for bonfire night when the cut off is 12pm.
- Selling or Using fireworks illegally could lead up to being imprisoned for 6 months.
- You could also get an on-the-spot fine of £90.

## Where to use fireworks?

- Organised event by licensed professionals
- Private property (remembering safe distance)
- Fireworks cannot be used on the streets or in a public place.
