## Incidents reported during January 2022:

If you have information relating to the referenced incidents please call 101 quoting the number and date.

### Wellesbourne Area:

112-02/01 – Loxley Close, Wellesbourne

Damage caused to signs and plant pots outside of shop by three females who appeared to be drunk on the CCTV footage.

364-17/01 – Wellington Close, Wellesbourne

Male reported to be going door-to-door claiming to be from a charity which was believed to be suspicious.

280-19/01 – Sunderland Place, Wellesbourne

At approximately 16:00 hrs, male and female with clipboards entered property through unlocked front door, and asked victim questions about her home life. Victim has contacted neighbour and suspects have left area.

257 24/01 - Cozens Street, Wellesbourne

Between 20-22 January, spare wheel stolen from underneath vehicle.

185 29/01 - Brook Lane, Moreton Morrell

Between 24-28 January, lock broken on

a motorhome, and internal battery removed.

### Snitterfield Area:

229-06/01 – Farm Location, Snitterfield

Sheep worrying by a dog off the lead – sheep badly injured.

327-13/01 – Warwick Road, Black Hill

Theft of dirty and clean linen from external sheds at business location.

157-14/01 – Ingon Lane, Snitterfield

Approximately 140 discarded shop security tags found in woodland near location. Retrieved by SNT officers.

217-21/01 – Bearley Road, Snitterfield

Parked van entered and tools stolen. Front window also smashed during incident.

205 29/01 - Warwick Rd, Black Hill

Theft of approximately £240 worth of goods from shop location.

### Kineton Area:

205-11/01 – Banbury Road, Lighthorne

Vehicle has been keyed down one side whilst parked in a staff car park at location.

287 23/01 - B4100, near Gaydon.

Group of males in vehicles driving in an anti-social manner and racing up and

down the road and the associated roundabouts near to the British Motor Museum.

248 26/01 - Chadshunt

Report of a suspicious male who was asking occupants various questions about valuable items that may be in the property. Concern this was not with good intentions.

### Burton Dassett area:

125-02/01 – Farm Location, Little Dassett

3 sets of number plates found near location.

191-15/01 – Tysoe Road, Radway

Between 1700 14/01 and 1030 15/01, entry has been gained to a secured shipping container and various items stolen including bell tents, horse tack, generator, and a chainsaw.

192-18/01 – Burton Dassett Hills Country Park

One set of number plates and one lone number plate found at location by litter pickers.

4 30/01 - Shop location, Warmington

Unknown offenders have removed window frame and bars and entered property to carry out a search - nothing stolen.
