We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and will prioritise the following,

What you have said	Action taken
"There have been issues with obstructions on roads and parking around schools at drop off times"	High visibility patrols have taken place by the team. Work is underway with our force children and young person officer to visit and provide road safety advice to some of the children. We are also liaising with the council for support from their camera car.
"There have been problems with antisocial behaviour in and around the Thurmaston shopping centre"	Regular patrols have taken place at the shopping centre where we have engaged with the retail community as well as young people at the location to prevent repeat incidents of youths acting in an antisocial manner and attending at key times of potential car meets at the location, This priority has also been tasked to the ASB car to incorporate in their patrol plans
"Speeding is a concern"	Regular patrols have been conducted in areas highlighted as a concern. The team have been attending the location of known car meets and have speed operation planned in the coming weeks.

What to be aware of!


Another reminder of darker nights:

As darker nights are drawing in, we would like to remind the community to keep good crime prevention habits.

Here is a checklist for when you are leaving your home unattended:

- Make your home look occupied by leaving a few lights on.
- If you are out all day/night, then it's advisable to use a light timer device to automatically turn on your lights and radios, when your home is unoccupied.
- In the evening, shut curtains and leave a light on.
- Close and lock all windows and doors (even if you're only going out for a few minutes).
- Double-lock any doors.
- Make sure that any valuables are out of sight and away from letter boxes, e.g. car keys, wallets/purses, handbags.
