BONFIRE NIGHT REMEMBER! REMEMBER!

- It is illegal to sell fireworks to anyone under 18 years of age. Maximum penalty of £5000 and/or six months in prison.
- X It is illegal to set off fireworks between 11pm and 7am (Bonfire night extended until 12 midnight).
- It is illegal to let off any firework in a public place and this carries a fine of up to £5000. Police may also issue an £90 Fixed Penalty Notice.

- All fireworks sold to the public X must comply to British Safety Standard BS 7114.
 - The police have the power to stop and search anyone suspected of carrying fireworks.
- The sale of banger, mini X rockets, fireworks that fly erratically (squibs, helicopters etc), aerial shells and maroons is illegal.
- Irresponsible use of fireworks X can damage property, cause injury, scare people (particularly the elderly) and frighten animals.

Theft of used cooking oil that had been put out for collection by a recycling company.

Report of a deer being hit and injured by informant's car.

146-22/10 Geden Close, Kineton

Theft of a used tumble drier that had been put out for pre-arranged scrap collection.

Theft of used and unused cooking oil. Offenders reported to be in a white transit van.
